



Community Garden Rules & Regulations

1. Each Gardener is responsible for maintenance and up-keep of their garden plot. Watering, weeding, harvesting, and any other garden related maintenance are all the responsibility of the gardener.
2. Produce may not be sold.
3. Children are welcome in the garden but must be accompanied by an adult and supervised.
4. All trash (paper, plastic, cans, etc.) must be properly disposed of.
5. TURN OFF water before leaving the garden
6. Keep the lock combination confidential.
7. **No herbicides, pesticides or chemical fertilizers are allowed.** If there are any questions about organic gardening, please contact the garden coordinator.
8. Garden plots should be cared for once a week. It is the gardener's responsibility to notify the coordinator if he or she is not able to care for their plot in any given week. If any plot remains unattended for more than three weeks that plot may be reassigned.
9. NO SMOKING in or on garden property. If you are caught smoking, garden privileges will be revoked at the garden coordinator's discretion.
10. NO PETS on Garden Property.
11. At the end of the of the growing season, but no later than October 31, gardeners are responsible to clear their plot of all plant material and leave the plot as they found it at the time of planting.
12. Report theft, vandalism, and unusual activities to the garden coordinator and police.
13. Use common courtesy; be considerate of your gardening neighbors. Help your fellow gardener.
14. All disputes will be brought to the attention of the garden coordinator and dealt with accordingly.



15. Since this is a community garden, each gardener is expected to contribute approximately 4 hours of labor in maintaining the garden. This would include 1 hour for spring preparation, 2 hours of summer maintenance, and 1 hour for fall cleanup.

16. Garden privileges may be revoked at the garden coordinator's discretion.
